Please help us by ensuring all items of clothing, including ties and coats are named clearly.

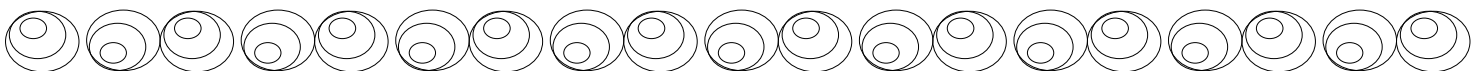
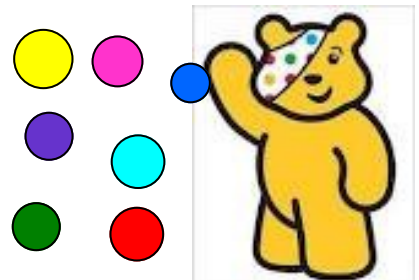
