Please would you ensure that your dinner money accounts are up to date.

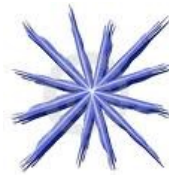
It really helps the office if you can bring in the right money and avoid large notes as we do not keep large amounts of change in the office.

At 9.30am**



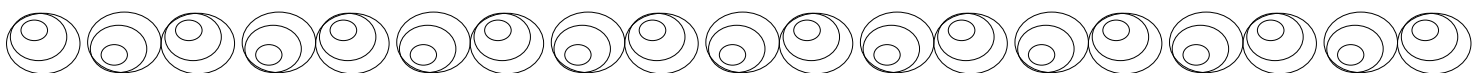

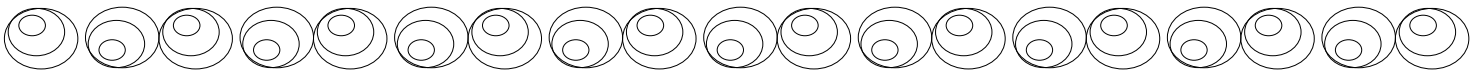

Parking



As I am sure you are aware, we have been monitoring the car park to ensure that everyone is parking correctly. We are still battling with a few parents who double park and block people in; park in the care home or park on the yellow zig-zag lines. I am amazed by parents who inform us that they are willing to take the risk of getting a fine and it is ok to park where they like as they are not going to be long. This is not the issue! Parking irresponsibly means that other people cannot leave the car park promptly which adds to the queuing to get out of the car park. Parking in the care home results in care workers and emergency workers not being able to get to work on time. The yellow zig zag lines are there to keep the crossing clear and ensure drivers can clearly see young children crossing. Parking on them blocks the view of drivers and puts our children at risk.
