#### **BUMP NOTE PROCEDURES**

Some of you may be aware that we have changed our bump note procedures to ensure parents are always aware that a child has had a bump on the head/face.

If your child tells any member of staff that they have received a bump on the head or face, however minor, we will complete a red bump form and you will now receive a text message to inform you that you need to look for the red bump note coming home with your child.

If your child receives a more serious bump to the head or the bump has caused a mark on their face, we will ring you to explain what has happened and to explain to you what mark can be seen.

Please do not worry if your child comes home with lots of red bump notes, it is quite normal, especially with the younger children who are still developing their spatial awareness.
