



We have recently been reviewing progress across the school and it has been highlighted how important it is for parents to be reading regularly with their children as children who

MORNING REGISTRATION



The children can be dropped off on the infant playground from 8.30am where a member of staff will be on duty. At 8.45am the bell will ring and the children line up to be taken into school. If you are running late but it is before 9am, your child should enter school via the infant playground, in the usual manner. Only **after 9am** should children be brought into school via the main office. The children will be expected to take themselves into class from the office.

On wet mornings, the school is open from 8.30am and the children can come straight in. Whether it is wet or dry, please could parents send their children in by themselves. There are teachers and teaching assistants available to help the children if necessary. We just do not have the room to accommodate all parents as well and once one parent is inside others will follow!!!

If you need to speak to a member of staff, after school is a better time alternatively if it is important, please come into the school office earlier to see if your child's teacher is available. Any quick messages can be written in the school planners.
