




What is Tapestry?

Tapestry is an online Learning Journal. Learning Journals are special books that early year's settings use to record and share observations, notes and photos that are made for each child. These help us to assess your child's development and enable us to identify and support their next steps for learning. While Learning Journals are traditionally collated as scrapbooks or in folders using photos and post it notes, Tapestry allows these notes and observations to be made using a tablet, phone or computer.



How can I access Tapestry?

Your registered email address is the primary email address you gave to the school- your initial password will be emailed to this address. Tapestry can be accessed on a computer, tablet and smartphone.



To access Tapestry using the computer go to:

This will take you straight to the login page where you can login using your email address and password.

The login screen will look like this (left).


To access Tapestry using a tablet or smartphone:



Go to the app store as you would to download any other app and search "Tapestry EYFS". The app logo looks like this (left). It is a free app. Once you have downloaded the app you will be able to login using your email address and password. You are also asked to create a 4-digit pin. This can be anything that you will remember, it means you don't have to enter your email address and password each time.


How can I get involved at home?

One of the great features of Tapestry is that, with a registered login, you can access your child's learning journey from home and keep up to date with the things they are learning in school and their development. You can also add comments onto observations, ask questions, celebrate achievements and add your own photos and videos of the things you have been doing together at home.



What type of replies or observations should I add?

Whether it is a photo of your child practicing their sounds, a video of your child now being able to stand on one foot, or a note saying that you have been enjoying a new story together; we value parents as partners in their child's learning and look forward to seeing your voice as part of your child's learning Journal.
