Our Trip to the British Museum



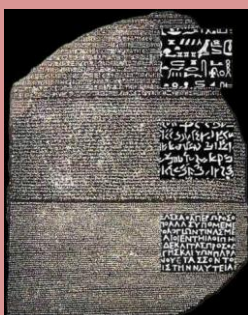
On the 2nd of November Year 5 and Year 6 went to the British Museum. We went as it was part of our topic: Ancient Egypt.
