Parents are welcome to come to any part of the day. We hope that as many parents as possible will be able to join us for the picnic on the field. If your child usually has a school dinner, the kitchen staff will arrange for a ham, tuna or cheese sandwich to be available on this day.

The activity circus is a series of activities that the children will take part in to earn points for their house team. They will be placed in house teams with children from the other year groups and spend 3 minutes at each activity trying to score points for their team. Where possible, siblings will be placed in the same team so parents can follow children round at the same time. At the end of both activity circuses, the points will be added and the house with the highest score will be awarded the cup.

Children from each class can choose to compete in the sprint races. In the morning they will compete in the heats and then the final sprint races will be held in the afternoon. There will be a race for girls and a race for boys.

The house relay will involve all the children. There will be a team from each house in each year group. They will earn points for their house based on their position and the relay cup will be presented to the highest scoring cup.

At the end of the day, the children will return to their classes and will be dismissed as usual. This may be earlier than the usual time of 3.20pm. Unfortunately if the weather means the event is cancelled, we do not have a reserve date this year.

Wake Up & Shake Up

From September there will be exciting new changes to our early morning Wake Up and Shake Up Club.

As well as continuing our different activities each day, we will also be offering the children the opportunity to spend their time on quieter activities like board games, simple (non messy) craft activities and puzzles.

The cost per session is £4, booked half termly.

The children can choose either activity in the morning, it is up to them.
