PLEASE HELP!

Please would all parents help with these 3 matters below.

We are still battling with a small number of children who are late into school every day. Even being five minutes late has an impact on the class and the office.

Although we understand that there may be odd times when a lateness occurs, it is not acceptable to be late every day and you are not helping your children as those children who are repeatedly late are missing vital early morning work.

You are also not preparing them for later life.

The new electronic gates are there to keep your children even safer. We still have a very small number of children/parents walking through the car park gate if they notice it is open. I have even seen two children, with adults, squeezing themselves through the gates forcing them open! The gate is on a sensor so if you keep walking through when it has opened for a car, the gate will remain open and this defeats the object of putting the new security gates in.

In the mornings the side doors to the playground are open to allow staff out onto the playground and children into the building. Please would all adults refrain from 'just popping' in to look or check for things before school or to see the teachers. If you need to speak to a member of staff or look from something in the classroom/ cloakroom, please go the main office and someone will help you.

We need to know exactly who is in the building for fire safety reasons and staff are always really busy setting up for the start of the day and do not always have the time to speak openly. A member of staff (usually me) is always on the playground from 8.30am and we are always happy to help in any way.

I really appreciate your cooperation in these three matters.

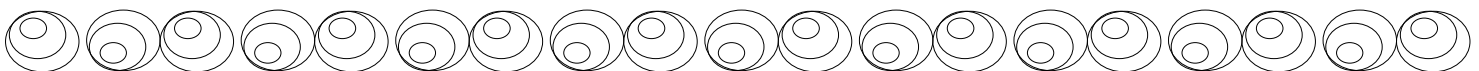

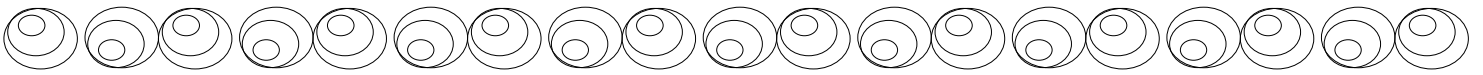
