This is fantastic and probably the best overall set of attendance for a term we have ever had.

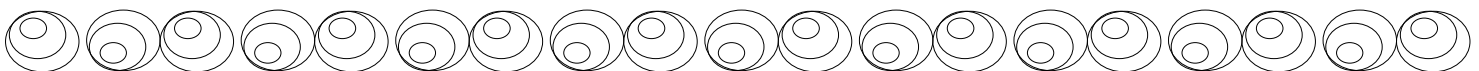

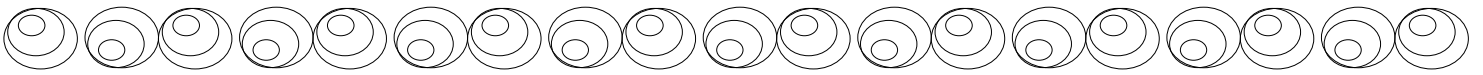
Next FOLS Meeting
