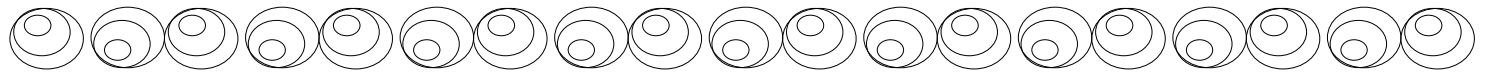
Well done to Y2, Y3, Y4 and Y6 who exceeded our target.

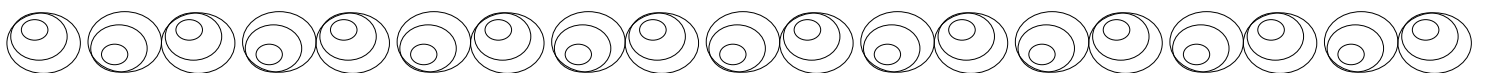
Do you have any clean, clear jam jars that you can donate for the winter fair? If you can help, please bring the jars into the school office before Friday 4th December.

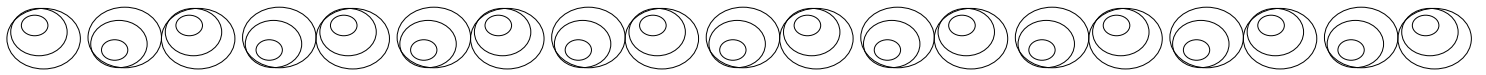

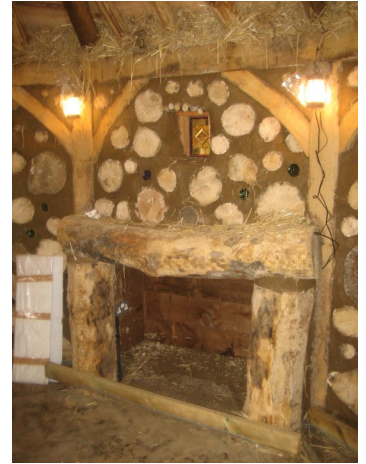
Diabetes Awareness and Children in Need
