Parents are welcome to come to any part of the day. We hope that as many parents as possible will be able to join us for the picnic on the field. If your child usually has a school dinner, Mrs Moore, our school cook will arrange for a red and a green packed lunch to be available on this day.

The activity circus is a series of activities that the children will take part in to earn points for their house team. They will be placed in house teams with children from the other year groups and spend 3 minutes at each activity trying to score points for their team. Where possible, siblings will be placed in the same team so parents can follow children round at the same time. At the end of both activity circuses, the points will be added and the house with the highest score will be awarded the cup.

Children from each class can choose to compete in the sprint races. There will be a race for girls and a race for boys. If too many children want to take part in each class, there will be a heat followed by a final.

The house relay will involve all the children. There will be a team from each house in each year group. They will earn points for their house based on their position and the relay cup will be presented to the highest scoring cup.
