# KEEPING OUR CHILDREN SAFE!

**Please take the time to read these reminders and share them with your children. All of the points below are made in your children's best interest and we hope you will support us with them.**

## DRIVING/PARKING IN AND AROUND WATKINS RISE

Please can I remind all drivers about driving slowly around the school area. As important as it is for parents to ensure that their children are behaving safely around cars, we all know that children can be easily distracted and unpredictable. Please drive slowly and be extra vigilant to help ensure we do not have any accidents.

We are very lucky to have any car park at all outside our school but I do understand how frustrating it is when you are unable to park. Some parents are double parking in the car park, which is fine **IF** you stay in the car to wait for your child. Under no circumstances should you leave your car unattended blocking another car in.

**Please switch off your car engine while you are waiting for your child to come out of school.**

Can I also remind you not to park in the Mayfair Lodge car park at any time.

## SCOOTING/CYCLING ON SCHOOL GROUNDS

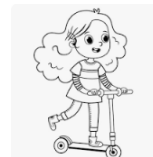
