

Maths at Ladbroke

The children have responded well to our Talk Maths sessions happening across Key Stage 1 and 2. Here the children are given a reasoning question to talk through, in small groups, in order to prove it, explain it, answer true/false statements relating to it and finally solve it. The teachers have commented that these sessions have supported the children in building their confidence back up as they returned to school fully, and in particular with using mathematical vocabulary.
