We will also be hosting a meeting for the new reception parents, in the hall from 6.30pm.

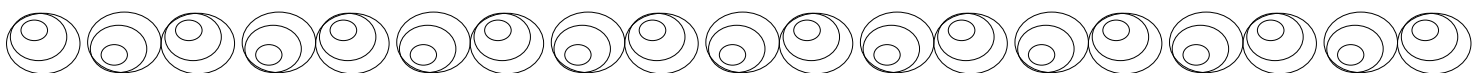


### Residential Trips

## Looking Ahead to September!

With only 2 weeks left of the school year, we have started planning the new school year. Some of you may also be thinking of the new year and with that in mind, I want to ensure you have as much information as you need in case, like me, you like to plan ahead.

### START AND END OF THE DAY

From September 2022, we will be returning to our old drop off and pick up times. Although we have trialled the later staggered start, we are still getting children turning up late and with the staggered start this is even later than usual and causing more disruption to class. The chart below explains how the start and end of the day will work.

#### (FROM SEPTEMBER)

8.30	Gates Open	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Children come into school and wait on the KS1 playground</li><li>• Miss Webster or a senior member of staff will open the gate and then wait on the playground to supervise</li><li>• Parents are welcome to wait on the playground until the bell goes</li></ul>
8.40	Doors Open for FS2 - Y6	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Bell is rung and the children line up to go into school. Each class will go in through their nominated door</li></ul>
9.00	Nursery Starts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Nursery Door opens</li></ul>
2.55pm	Gates Open	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The gates will be opened for pick up</li><li>• A member of staff will be on duty</li><li>• Parents can freely come onto school grounds to collect children</li></ul>
3.00pm	FS1 & FS2 Finish	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Nursery and Reception will finish at 3pm</li></ul>
3.15pm	Y1-Y6 Finish	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• End of the school day for Y1—Y6</li><li>• Children in Y1 and Y2 should be collected by an adult</li><li>• If you wish your child (From Y3-Y6) to walk to the gate to be met by an adult you will need to inform the office again at the start of each academic year.</li></ul>
4.15pm	Sports Clubs Finish	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Please collect from the designated places on site.</li><li>• If your child is in Y6 and walks home this must be confirmed in writing on the gateway</li></ul>

Where possible, the one way system will remain in place.

### PE KITS

We will continue wearing PE kits to school on days when the children have PE. We will inform you each term of your child's PE days and they may change due to timetabling in school.

School PE kits includes plain black trainers. They should be plain black with no other colours on them. Plain navy blue shorts or tracksuit bottoms should be worn. Leggings should not be worn. Blue polo shirts and normal school jumpers or cardigans should be worn.

All items need to be labelled. Please bring a small bag for the children to bring reading books and water bottles to and from school. We have limited space in the cloakrooms and if bags are too big, they often end up on the floor in the rummage to get coats on.
