Mobile phones should not be used on the school premises.



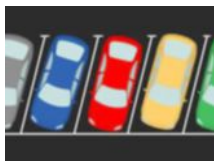
If your child is riding a bike or scooter to school, please make sure they get off the bike or scooter before they enter the school grounds. No cycling or using scooters on school grounds is permitted
