Important Reminders

Over the past few weeks, I have noticed an increased number of children arriving into school late and coming into school with the wrong uniform on.

Please can all families make sure that, unless otherwise agreed with the school, that children are wearing the correct uniform. The main issues are highlighted below.

- Shirts and ties should be worn**
- Trainers should be plain black**
