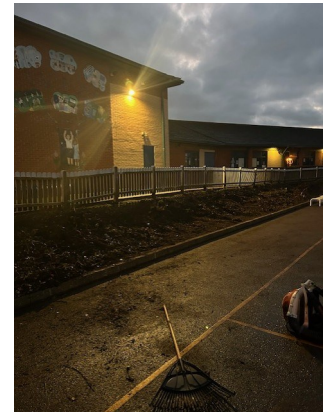
### Happy New Year—The Bushes are Gone!!!
