HEADTEACHER'S NEWSLETTER

Welcome Back

With the new lockdown now started, at Ladbroke we will try to keep everything as much as the same as we can do and ask all parents coming onto site to do following social distancing rules and leave the site as soon as possible.

I appreciate that another lockdown is not the news that anyone wanted. With the darker nights and miserable weather, we understand that this lockdown may be even harder for some families. Please remember that we are always here if you need advice or just a listening ear. We are all in this together and as always, our Ladbroke school community is great at providing support where necessary. Everyone has times when everything can feel overwhelming so whatever your worry, however small. We are here to help.

Remote Learning

Over the past 2 months I have been working alongside RM Education to set up Microsoft Teams so that in the event of a lockdown we had a learning platform we could use to deliver work and ensure we are giving feedback. We hope to have this ready really soon and will send out more details, including information for children and parents on how to use Teams. Reception and Nursery children will continue to use Tapestry for all their remote learning

We are putting together a package of remote learning based on the following three scenarios

Scenario 1—Your child is off and awaiting a test result

A pack of work will be provided for your child to work on at home for the few days they are off. It will be based on skills and knowledge that they need to develop and will support learning in the classroom

Scenario 2—Your child needs to isolate for 14 days

A pack of work will be provided initially and then work will be uploaded to Microsoft Teams for your child to access. It will be a mixture of pre recorded lessons and videos created for lockdown
Work should be completed and uploaded to the site so teachers can give feedback

Scenario 3 – The class has to isolate due to a case in school

The teacher will provide three lessons each day, one maths, one English and one afternoon lesson.

In addition to this a challenge homework challenge will be set for the children to work through.

More information will be provided on this over the coming days.




LEEJOYS


