English:

Ok Year 1 it's time to get creative. Remember those keywords you grouped with their rhyming friends yesterday? Well we are going to use them today to write a Spring time themed poem. A seasonal picture has been included to give you some extra ideas and the words that rhyme are used at the end of two sentences to create a pair of rhyming couplets.

For example: **Spring** and **sing**
My favourite time is the season of **Spring**,
It makes me happy and my heart will **sing**.

Try to say a few ideas out loud before choosing your lines and don't be afraid to rearrange your sentences to help words fit. Once you have a pair then add another to create a Spring time poem verse.

Eg: The cold starts to leave and out comes the **sun**,
I can't wait to go play and have lots of **fun**.

After that feel free to add as many more as you like and use other words that rhyme too.

Good luck with your poem creating and send them to us too when finished if you like as we would love to hear them.

Maths (Time):

I have attached a 'Telling the time board game' this is a fun way to learn the time with your child. If you cannot access the file there are other games you can play. You could draw a few clock times and scatter them around the house. The children will have to find them and tell the time. You could have a competition to see who can find the most.

Topic (RE):

With Easter coming up it's a good idea for children to know how Christians celebrate Easter. Watch this clip to give children a better understanding.
