- Homophones are words that sound the same but are spelt differently and have different meanings. (e.g. *which*, *witch*)
- Near homophones are words that almost sound the same but have different spellings and meanings. (e.g 'of' and 'off'; 'were' and 'where'; or 'our' and 'are')
- Use the homophones word mat to check that you have chosen the correct homophone spellings.

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Key Word Castle

Exit here to check your use of key words.

- 'Key' words are words that are necessary to include in your writing.
- They can be:
 - High frequency words (words we use most commonly)
 - Topic-related words that are linked to the genre

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Ambitious Word Academy

Exit here to check your spelling of ambitious words.

- Ambitious words can be:
- High utility words - *e.g. conclude, apparent, examine*
- Powerful verbs - *e.g. sauntered, exclaimed, rampaged*
- Adjectives - *e.g. exceptional, claret, horrendous*
- Adverbs - *e.g. menacingly, gracefully, cautiously*
- Year 3 & 4 words or Year 5 & 6 words

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
