Title: Sapphire Battersea

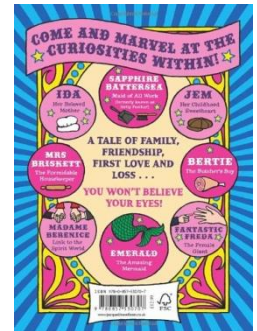
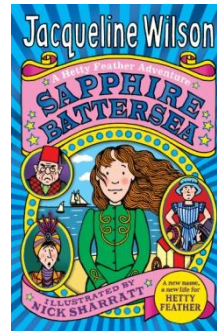
